What is R.C.I.A.?

- It is a process through which a person who is **interested in the Catholic Faith** can learn more about the Church.
- It is an exciting journey of growth and discovery into **an experience of Jesus Christ in our lives** within the context of St. Robert Bellarmine parish.

Who is R.C.I.A. for?

- A person who has **never been baptized**
- One who has been **baptized in another faith** but is interested in the Catholic Church
- A baptized Catholic who has not received any further sacraments
- A Catholic who would like to learn more about the faith
